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## MORNING REVIVAL

**MORNING CHALLENGE:** This booklet contains a daily 2 to 3-minute morning challenge designed to help you open your entire being and turn to the Lord in your spirit. Because our spirit is like a muscle, we must exercise it in order for it to be strong. So, do not be surprised if these simple challenges are harder than they seem. Like with physical exercise, it may be best to do the challenges with a partner.

**PERSONAL MORNING REVIVAL:** Spend 7 minutes with the Lord alone or with a companion. The key is to do this routinely in the morning with or without feeling! Do not be distracted by any thing, thought, feeling or person around you! The practices below should help you to touch the Lord, and to be enlightened, strengthened, nourished and supplied by Him.

<b>Calling</b>	<p>Begin by calling on the name of the Lord at least three times, from deep within, audibly.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>Oh Lord Jesus! Oh Lord Jesus! Oh Lord Jesus!</i></p>
<b>Praying</b>	<p>Pray the following prayer, audibly, so your own ears can hear, even if softly, and from your heart:</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>Lord Jesus, I come to You with an open heart. Forgive me of my sins and cleanse me with Your precious blood. Thank You for a new day. Grant me a new beginning. Lord, open me to Your Word right now and speak to me. Shine on me.</i></p>
<b>Pray-reading</b>	<p>Pray-read two or three verses from the memory verse list audibly, applying the contents of the verses to yourself.</p>
<b>Confession</b>	<p>Continue praying and confess audibly (but not so loud that others around you can hear you) any sins or mistakes that you feel the Lord is enlightening you concerning. Try to be specific, even mentioning details and motives.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>Lord Jesus, I love You. Lord forgive me for _____.</i> <i>Oh Lord Jesus, thank You for cleansing me.</i></p>
<b>Consecration</b>	<p>Pray to consecrate yourself to the Lord for today.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>Dear Lord Jesus, I give myself to You afresh. Make Your home in my heart a little more. Lord, I need you and I love You.</i></p>
<b>Thanksgiving</b>	<p>Give thanks and praise to the Lord.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>Lord, thank you for today. Thank You for a new day. Thank you for my parents and my family and my home. Lord, thank You for giving me the Bible and Your Spirit. Lord, praise You! You are everything I need. Jesus is Lord!</i></p>
<b>Petition</b>	<p>Pray for others by name or for personal needs or guidance.</p>

## PRACTICAL POINTS ON HOW TO COMPOSE A PROPHECY

**COMPOSE:** Try your very best to compose as short a prophecy as you possibly can. This helps your prophecy be clear and to the point. It is always best to compose your prophecy so that it is from half a minute to one and a half minutes long. Use the following example as a guide for your composition (Composition example taken from *The Triune God, A Lesson Book* published by Living Stream):

1) **My Revelation:** One short sentence that states what I saw, enjoyed, or was impressed with.

Ex.: *Because God is triune, He can be in us and we can be in Him.*

2) **My Verse:** One or two verses that explain my revelation. It is better to read them from the Bible.

Ex.: *Listen to the first part of 1 Cor. 1:30, "But of Him you are in Christ Jesus..."*

3) **My Development:** One short sentence that explains my verse and my revelation.

Ex.: *Because God is the processed Triune God, He can get into us and we can get into Him.*

4) **My Conclusion:** One short sentence to conclude, summarize, or end your prophecy.

Ex.: *Hallelujah! The Triune God is in me and I am in Him.*

**PRACTICE:** After composing, practice speaking your prophecy to yourself or to others. Time your speaking so that you only speak between half a minute to one and a half minutes. It is OK to start your prophecy by reading your verse and stating your revelation as you read the verse (Example: you could say, "The Bible came from God's breath, His very being and 2 Tim 3:16 proves this because it says, All Scripture is God-breathed..."). Then continue the rest of your prophecy.

**LISTEN:** When you come to the meeting, whether large or small, exercise to listen to others' prophecies and try not to be anxious about giving your prophecy. Since you have already seen something in the Lord's Word, composed your prophecy, and practiced, you are ready. By listening to the other saints speak, you will know when the appropriate time is to speak your prophecy. Listen and be ready to speak.

**EXERCISE YOUR SPIRIT TO SPEAK:** Then, when you speak, do not forget to exercise your spirit, that is, push out your voice with your breath. Speak loud enough for all to hear, without shouting. It is always best to read your verse directly from the Bible but try not to read the other portions of your prophecy. Look at the saints. Limit your speaking to half a minute and not more than one and a half minutes. Always exercise your spirit. Enjoy the Lord in your speaking, because it is God speaking His Word into and out of you. Remember, if you mess up, it is always better to be livingly wrong than dead right. So, always exercise your spirit!

## SSOT CHALLENGE

During the week of the Summer School of Truth (SSOT), you will be asked to participate in various activities. Depending on the size of your locality, you may be assigned into groups or your locality may be your group. Groups will have the opportunity to gain points for each of the activities. At the end of the week, prizes will be awarded to those teams that score the highest total points. These prizes are meant to serve as a small incentive; however, always remember the focus of the SSOT is not to compete, but to gain a rich deposit.

**MEMORY VERSE:** Every day each group will be assigned two memory verses. Groups should practice together to make sure every member knows the verses and is ready to recite them. Before you end the day, your worker must submit a video of your group reciting the verses. Be creative! You may use motions or props to help those watching the video remember the verse. Points will be awarded based on four categories: Accuracy, coordination, creativity and release/exercise.

**VIRTUAL BOOKLET:** As a group, work together to develop a *virtual booklet* regarding the SSOT. Think of it as a short video (no more than 5 minutes) that can be used as a summary of something you enjoyed or learned during the week. You should consider the audience to be someone who is not as familiar with the topic, like one of your friends at school. So you want the video to be something that explains the truth, whets their appetite, and is something they can relate to as a fellow young person. The format can be a *testimonial*, or *infomercial*, a brief summary, etc. Your final video must be submitted by your worker before the end of the SSOT. Points will be awarded based on participation of group members and creativity.

**SONGS/POEMS:** Points will also be awarded for songs or poems completed by groups on a volunteer basis. Songs or poems can be originals (highly recommended). But you can also use an existing song if you add motions and are released as a group when you sing. Videos of songs or poems may be submitted at any time during the SSOT.

## Morning Revival

**Ephesians 5:19-20** – Speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and psalming with your heart to the Lord, giving thanks at all times for all things in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ to our God and Father.

**Hebrews 13:15** – Through Him then let us offer up a sacrifice of praise continually to God, that is, the fruit of lips confessing His name.

### Singing and Praising

There must be the sound of praise and singing in the early morning. The early morning is the best time to sing praises to God. When we offer our highest praise to God, our spirit rises to the highest peak.

Songs are the expression of man's finest feelings. The sentiments of man's prayer before God cannot match the sentiments of his songs before God; the former are never as fine and tender as the latter. God wants us to have fine and tender feelings. This is why He gives us many kinds of songs in the Bible. In addition to the Psalms, the Song of Songs, and Lamentations, there are also songs in the history and the commandments (Exo. 15:1-18; Deut. 32:1-43). Even in Paul's Epistles, we find hymns interspersed in his teachings (Rom. 11:33-36; 1 Tim. 3:16).

Our Lord's feelings are fine and tender. We have fine feelings as well as harsh feelings. Wrath and anger are clearly harsh feelings. Some people are not full of wrath, but their feelings are not fine either. God

wants us to be patient, compassionate, merciful, and sympathetic because all these are fine feelings. God wants us to sing in the midst of our trials and to praise and bless His name in the midst of our pain because all these are expressions of fine feelings. When a person loves another person, his feeling is tender. When he forgives or shows mercy to others, his feeling is also tender.

God wants to lead His children toward a walk of finer, tenderer, and more song-like feelings. The more a person learns of God, the finer, tenderer, and more song-like his feelings become. Those who learn little before God are rough and unrefined in their feelings. The deepest feelings that flow from a man's heart are the feelings expressed in songs. We do not want harsh feelings. Harsh feelings have nothing to do with hymns; they do not belong to a Christian.

Many times praise works where prayer fails. This is a very basic principle. If you cannot pray, why not praise? The Lord has placed another item in your hands for your victory and for you to boast in victory. When- ever you run out of strength to pray and you find your spirit heavily oppressed, wounded, or sagging, praise Him. If you cannot pray, try to praise. We invariably think that we should pray when the burden is heavy and praise when the burden is over. But please bear in mind that there are times when the burden is so heavy that you cannot pray. That is the time for you to praise. We do not praise when there is no burden; we praise when the burden becomes too heavy. When you encounter unusual circumstances and problems and are bewildered and feel like collapsing, just remember one thing,

“Why not praise?” Here is a golden opportunity. If you offer your praise at that moment, God's Spirit will operate in you, open all the doors, and break all the chains.

**MORNING CHALLENGE:** Spend **three** minutes singing a love song to the Lord. As the Lord touches you, stop and pray short prayers over the words and phrases you are singing. Then keep singing the song to the Lord.

**Morning Revival**

**John 4:24** – God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truthfulness.

**1 John 1:9** – If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

**Prayer and Confessing**

Prayer is for contacting God and having fellowship with Him. The emphasis here is not on asking God concerning different matters. Prayer is a means and a way of fellowship. The real meaning of prayer is to contact God and absorb Him.

Prayer that contacts God consists of words spoken genuinely from the heart. We must pray according to our inward feeling. We should not exercise our mind like a student taking an exam. Neither should we focus on the wording of prayer as if we are writing an essay. Such prayers are not very genuine; they are rather pretentious. When we come before God to pray, we should not be pretentious. We should speak what we feel within. When we are angry, we should voice our anger before God. When we are happy, we should voice our happiness before God. When we are sad, we should voice our sadness before God. When we are under pressure, we should speak of this pressure before God. When we sense that we are sinful, we should confess it before God. We should speak what we feel within, speaking genuine words from our heart.

## FRIDAY – JULY 30

When we come before God without being pretentious or memorizing the things we need to pray for and we simply place ourselves before Him and let the Holy Spirit shine in us, He causes us to sense and see certain sins or mistakes that we have committed. At that time, we should confess the sin according to this sense. We should confess only as much as we sense. We do not need to take care of what we have not sensed. While confessing, we need to receive the precious blood, rely on the blood, and apply the effectiveness of the blood. If we continue praying in this way, we can be assured that we will touch God's presence and contact Him.

**MORNING CHALLENGE:** Call on the name of the Lord for **two** minutes. Begin slow, from deep within, with a soft voice. Do your best to go deeper each time you call. Do not stop until the two minutes are up.

### Faith and Loving the Lord

We believe in Jesus Christ by His faith, for we have no faith of our own. Jesus is the Author and Finisher of our faith. The more we look at ourselves and examine ourselves, the faster our faith disappears. Faith is not our invention; it can never be initiated by us. It is impossible for us to generate faith. If you look at yourself, you will never find faith, but if you forget about yourself and say, "O Lord Jesus, I love You," faith will immediately rise up within you. This faith is the faith of Jesus, or we may say it is Jesus believing within us. Thus, the phrase "through faith of Jesus Christ" means believing in Jesus Christ by His faith. The righteousness of God has been manifested apart from the law by our believing in Jesus Christ by His faith. We believe in Christ by His faith, not by our own. Christ is our faith. Never say that you cannot believe, for you can believe if you want to. Do not try to believe by yourself, because the more you try the less faith you have. Simply say, "O Lord Jesus, I love You. Lord Jesus, You are so good." If you do this, you will have faith immediately. We believe in Jesus Christ by His faith, and out of this faith and to this faith the righteousness of God is revealed to all who believe.

**MORNING CHALLENGE:** Tell the Lord you love Him for **two** minutes. Begin slow, from deep within, with a soft voice. Do your best to go deeper each time you call. Do not stop until the two minutes are up.

## Morning Revival

**Ephesians 6:17-18** – And receive the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which Spirit is the word of God, <sup>18</sup>By means of all prayer and petition, praying at every time in spirit...

### Pray-Reading

In what way are we to take the Word of God according to this passage? By means of all prayer and petition. This is what we call pray-reading. The Word of God must be taken by means of all prayer. When we come to the Bible, we should exercise both our mind and our spirit. We exercise our mind by reading and our spirit by praying. Since we need both to read and to pray, we should pray-read the Word. I can testify that through pray-reading my spirit becomes strong and ready to devour the enemy. I not only exercise my spirit, but I also exercise my mind to consider the Word.... The more my spirit is strengthened by pray-reading the Word, the more eager I am to use the sword of the Spirit to slay the enemy. Just pray-read the Word. Pray the words of the Bible exactly as they read. Eventually, you will see that the whole Bible is a prayer book! You can open to any page of the Bible and start to pray with any portion of the Word. Every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God is different from anything else, even the best of the world. Although you may not understand a certain passage, still you are nourished while pray-reading it, because there is really something of God in His Word; the Word of God is His very breath.

## Morning Revival

## Reading the Bible

In Greek the word rendered washing in verse 26 means laver. In the Old Testament, the priests wash themselves from earthly defilement in the laver (Exo. 30:18-21). Now the washing of the water washes us from defilement. Therefore, we are cleansed by the laver of the water in the Word. ...Day by day, morning and evening, we need to come to the Bible and be cleansed by the laver of water in the Word. By coming to the Word in this way, we are cleansed from the defilement we have accumulated in our contact with the world. Whenever you contact the world in the course of your human living, you need to come to the Word to be cleansed. One day Brother Nee was speaking about Bible reading. A certain sister told him that she had a poor memory and forgot everything she read in the Word. She asked Brother Nee what was the purpose for her to go on reading the Bible. In his answer, Brother Nee spoke of the way women in China wash rice in a willow basket. They dip the basket in and out of the water a number of times. Every time they take the basket out of the water, all the water flows out of the basket. Nevertheless, although the basket retains no water, both the basket and the rice are washed. He then applied this illustration to the reading of the Word. Although we may not retain anything of what we read, we are washed by it nonetheless, and we are cleansed. Let us be encouraged to come to the Word again and again to be washed...

### **Recovery Version Footnote Memorization Challenge**

**Gal 3:2 - This only I wish to learn from you, Did you receive the <sup>2</sup>Spirit out of the works of law or out of the hearing of faith**

Footnote 2 - The Galatians, through the hearing of the gospel, believed in the crucified Christ, but they received the Spirit. The One who was crucified on the cross was Christ, but the One who entered into the believers was the Spirit. In His being crucified for the believers' redemption He was Christ, but in His indwelling the believers to be their life He is the Spirit. This is the all-inclusive life-giving Spirit, who is the all-inclusive and ultimate blessing of the gospel. The believers receive such a divine Spirit by the hearing of faith, not by the works of law. He enters into the believers and lives in them not by their keeping of the law but by their faith in the crucified and resurrected Christ.

In the first two chapters of this Epistle there is Christ in the divine revelation as the focal point of God's economy, but in the last four chapters there is the Spirit in our experience for us to have the divine life (ch. 3), to be born of God (ch. 4), to live and walk by the regenerated life (ch. 5), and to take the divine purpose as our goal (ch. 6). Thus, we enjoy Christ continually as the all-inclusive life-giving Spirit (v. 5a).

**Romans 1:9 - For God is my witness, whom I serve in <sup>2</sup>my spirit in the gospel of His Son, how unceasingly I make mention of you always in my prayers**

Footnote 2 - Not the Spirit of God but Paul's regenerated spirit. The spirit is different from the heart, soul, mind, emotion, will, or natural life. Christ and the Spirit are with the believers in their regenerated human spirit (2 Tim. 4:22; Rom. 8:16). In this book Paul stressed that whatever we are (2:29; 8:5-6, 9), whatever we have (8:10, 16), and whatever we do toward God (v. 9; 7:6;

8:4, 13; 12:11) must be in this spirit. Paul served God in his regenerated spirit by the indwelling Christ, the life-giving Spirit, not in his soul by the power and ability of the soul. This is the first important item in his preaching of the gospel.

**1 Thes 5:23 - And the God of peace Himself sanctify you wholly, and may your <sup>5</sup>spirit and soul and body be preserved complete, without blame, at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ**

Footnote 5 - This word strongly indicates that man is of three parts: spirit, soul, and body. The spirit as our inmost part is the inner organ, possessing God-consciousness, that we may contact God (John 4:24; Rom. 1:9). The soul is our very self (cf. Matt. 16:26; Luke 9:25), a medium between our spirit and our body, possessing self-consciousness, that we may have our personality. The body as our external part is the outer organ, possessing world-consciousness, that we may contact the material world. The body contains the soul, and the soul is the vessel that contains the spirit. In the spirit, God as the Spirit dwells; in the soul, our self dwells; and in the body, the physical senses dwell. God sanctifies us, first, by taking possession of our spirit through regeneration (John 3:5-6); second, by spreading Himself as the life-giving Spirit from our spirit into our soul to saturate and transform our soul (Rom. 12:2; 2 Cor. 3:18); and last, by enlivening our mortal body through our soul (Rom. 8:11, 13) and transfiguring our body by His life power (Phil. 3:21).
